



Knitting Pattern - using 4.5 needles or size 8 Red Double Knitting Wool

Cast on 60 stitches and K ten rows

Row 11 - knit 2 together across the row, 30 stitches

Row 12 - slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over, continue across until 10 stitches remain

Cut wool and using a bodkin (or equivalent) thread wool through the 10 stitches. This forms a circle.

Sew up the side using the cast on length of thread and pull together at the top and tie with the cast-off thread. Do not cut off the ends.

Create a black centre using black wool by either knitting, crochet or sewing as you wish.
